- Experts from academic, industry, academia & research laboratories, alumni are invited in the design and periodic updation of the curricula.
- Workshop for curriculum development are held.
- At the time of introducing new courses, discussions are held to form lesson plans. Besides, workshops and faculty development programs are conducted to give orientation for new courses.

- Students are provided with incentives in the form of TA/DA for participation in the technical events like paper presentation, project competition, etc.
- Remedial classes are conducted for the disadvantaged. Besides, series of lectures are conducted by external experts upon invitation.
- All the young faculty members are encouraged to do Ph.D. and also faculty members are encouraged to secure projects from national and international funding agencies.
- University follows guidelines defined by UGC, AICTE, DCI, PCI, etc. to prepare the curricula with thrust on employment.
- Academic programs are in line with Vision and Mission of the University.
- Theoretical subjects are reinforced during the practical sessions.
- University strictly adheres to the academic calendar. Periodic evaluation for Teaching learning process and its effectiveness is carried out. The student performance on average of three sessional examinations is given weightage while awarding grades.
- Student attendance during theory and practical hours is monitored and counted towards their academic performance.
- Student feedback based on various aspects of teaching learning process is obtained and remedial actions are taken to address any lacuna.

The University shall undertake programs and projects for development of human resources, both through formal and non-formal delivery systems, in areas of professional pursuits in all walks of human endeavours, with accent on relevance, value addition, societal needs and futuristic pilot projects.

6.3 Quality improvement strategies adopted by the institution for each of the following:

6.3.1 Curriculum Development

1. It is responsibility of each department that the curriculum is updated as per market demand.
2. BoS is composed of senior faculty members of dept., industry experts and invited experts
3. Board of Studies (BOS) meeting held every semester for syllabus revision/restructuring/electives and sends for approval to AC.
4. AC at University level examines the proposal sent by BoS and approves/disapproves it.
5. Major restructuring of any course if required is carried out only after 3 years of successful running.

6.3.2 Teaching and Learning

1. Teaching plan is prepared and is adhered to by the faculty members.
2. Faculties are sent to attend short term training programmes/workshops/seminars.
3. Use of Power point presentation, e-learning resources.
4. Case based teaching pedagogy is applied in the most of the subjects and students are also given practical knowledge and field exposure along with theoretical foundation.
5. Inclusion of new topics beyond the syllabus is encouraged along with new experiments.
6. Process is adopted to identify weak students (based on their performance in regular Sessional exams) and counselling with faculty members is arranged to bring their performance to acceptable levels.

6.3.3 Examination and Evaluation

1. Implemented continuous and comprehensive evaluation system for examination and evaluation by holding sessional exams.
2. Continuous and periodic exam is conducted for overall evaluation of the students and for the weak students, remedial exam is conducted. It is compulsory for all the students to clear internal components before appearing for final university examinations.
3. At the end of internal examinations students are shown corrected answer sheets so that they can evaluate themselves and can get the idea how to overcome their lacuna. On demand students can see their evaluated answer books for the University Examinations.



Best practices in Infrastructure and learning resources

The total infrastructure development of the University is well planned and implemented at Central level. The planning and execution of infrastructure is done by Senior Professors from Department of Civil Engineering.

Thus high quality is maintained and the cost of infrastructural development is brought down significantly.

Good nearby hostel facilities catering to the needs of the students which provides healthy learning ambience and easy access to the university facilities.

Faculty of Dental Science has established a library with 8000 sq. feet carpet area. Faculty of Pharmacy likewise has established library with 1600 sq feet. carpet area.

Renovation of furniture has been carried out in Faculty of Technology library.

Annexure II

Best practices in Teaching, learning and Evaluations

Teaching Process: Faculty members across the campus participate in the workshops of curriculum development. Lesson plans ensure uniform coverage of syllabus in case of programmes offered across campus. It also ensures that the syllabus is covered in stipulated time. Faculty members are encouraged to develop lecture notes and presentations so that they can publish it and get feedback from a wider audience. This practice forces the faculty for continuously innovating newer ways of presenting and elucidating the course contents.

Learning Process: From DDU Alumni Association, students are provided with incentives in the form of TA / DA from funded research project funds for paper presentations in conferences. The slotted timetable system in Engineering programmes ensures maximum utilization of all resources. This facilitates conducting remedial classes and extra lab sessions for slow learners and for conducting co-curricular activities. The number of slots that are designed is more than the number of theory courses at least by one. These additional slot/slots is/are made use of running the remedial classes for the disadvantaged as well as conducting extramural lectures. Extra classes are taken for preparation of competitive examinations like GPAT/GATE. Online mock examination is conducted to improve capacity of students to pass the GPAT Exams.

Evaluation Process: Weightage for various components are decided in the course committee meetings and scheme of evaluation is prepared for unit tests/sessionals and end-semester evaluation. These are done with a view to ensure uniform evaluation of all the students taking the same course. Further, grading is given on a relative basis in MBA program and the evaluation on absolute basis exists in other courses. Auditing of question papers is done by external experts.

Annexure III

Research, Consultancy

The university has formed Board of Research Studies at University level and Research Committee at each Faculty level to facilitate and monitor funded and non-funded projects. The University has established a Research and Development center in area of Information & Communication Technology and has also established Center for Surface Science and Nanotechnology to promote research in the area of Nanotechnology and its applications in Industrial world. The Undergraduate students are encouraged to work in “R&D Center” and “Surface Science and Nanotechnology Center” in their final semester project training. Students are also given opportunity to work in internationally reputed research organizations like BISAG and IPR at Gandhinagar, SAC-ISRO at Ahmedabad, PRL at Ahmedabad and Udaipur, TRDDC, Pune, R&D Center of Reliance Industries Ltd., Vadodara and IIT, Bombay. Even the post graduate students are encouraged to do their dissertation work in above centers.

The University sponsors registration for International and National conferences for research publications and also provides duty leave to attend the same. There is a provision for incentive to faculty members on getting a paper published in a refereed journal.

All the students are encouraged to become members of the professional bodies in their discipline like ISTE, CSI and IEEE. The University has CSI, student branch and ISTE student branch.

Faculty of Dental Science has a Clinical material Research Laboratory to encourage its faculty and students.

The University has online subscription of IEEE journal and conference papers, Science Direct and Online Subscription of ASCE JNL.

Faculty of Dental Science has adopted a General Hospital of Uttarsanda- a nearby village of Nadiad, where faculty members provide dental treatment to village people.

The University has signed several MOUS with different organizations to facilitate various activities like research, extension, consultancy, faculty exchange and development, students training and placement etc.

Quality working plan for achievement of quality objectives of the University, for the academic year 2014 -2015

DDU has implemented quality management system since 1-4-2002 in all of its departments/disciplines. The University has been following its quality policy in words and in spirit. - e) D D U also comes in constant touch with industry representatives and experts because of it being `Anchor Institute - Chemicals & Petrochemicals`, promoted by Gujarat Government ,

for creating readily employable & Industry Responsive manpower in Chemicals & Petrochemicals . They also contribute in up gradation of course contents

iii. Faculty development :

The project also helps students in training, placement, Research activities & in their admission in research program.
- i. D D University being Anchor Institute for Chemicals & Petrochemicals \ appointed by Government of Gujarat has organized many training programs training many personnel consisting of faculties, men from industry & students all over Gujarat including from D D U itself.
- j. Research facility set up by Shah – Schulman Centre for Surface Science & Nanotechnology has also contributed in faculty development & student development
- k. Civil Department has earned consultation fees more than Rs. 0.75 lacs.
- l. Chemical engineering also has been earning large revenues every year.

v. Improving infrastructure:

For improvements in infrastructure of teaching following measures are taken.

- a. All faculty buildings/classrooms/laboratories, Seminar hall, Multimedia hall, central Examination hall etc. are well maintained & kept up to date by doing regular maintenance &

renovations. In F.Y. 2013-2014 D D U has spent Rs. 261.56 lacs in infrastructure maintenance & Rs. 291.20 Lacs in infrastructure development.

- b. Construction of new University office building is completed. Construction of separate buildings for Mechanical Engineering & IC is also completed. In existing university building second floor is constructed for providing more class rooms & common computing center. For Civil engineering also new building is being constructed
- c. Furniture & equipment's are also well maintained & replaced where found necessary.
- d. Existing building & other infrastructure facilities, including laboratories are used more intensively to ensure that University's activities go on with same momentum / growth, as before, without any interruption pending execution of expansion plans in this regard.
- e. During 1-4-05 to 31-3-09 the university has spent Rs.538 Lacs, for computers & other equipment's, furniture. Library & learning resources etc. from TEQUP grant funds.
- f. D D University has always ensured that requirements of all disciplines / Departments are met in time & in adequate manner. The Library has obtained 500 [L H Y 395] new books on different subjects. Our university has become member of DELNET making, there by rare books available for study on loan bases etc. Internet facility excess has been made available to still larger number & the facility has now been much faster. No discipline / department suffers due to inadequacy of infrastructure in D D University.
- g. Research facility set up by Shah – Schulman Centre for Surface Science & Nanotechnology of DD University has also immensely contributed in available infrastructure for research.
- h. D D University has been made Anchor Institute by Industry & Mines Department of Government of Gujarat for fastest growing of Chemicals & Petroleum sector of the state. The Anchor Institute, with required infrastructure, has conducted many training programs & trained personnel from industry, faculty members & students from all over Gujarat.

vi. Increasing student strength & setting up facility for higher education in existing disciplines: This half year no new facility for higher education in existing discipline is set up.

vii. Expanding teaching in other disciplines:

For academic year 2010-2011 the discipline of Mechanical Engineering was set up with intake of 60 students. This year Second batch for the Mechanical Engineering discipline will pass out.

D D University has from in academic year 2013-2014 set up specialization in Hotel Management at graduate level with intake of 30 students In BBA course..

D D University has in Academic Year 2014-2015 also setup B. Com. Course with English as medium for instruction.

viii. Increase in quantum & areas of consultation , Certification , R & D assignments:

Competition in the area has intensified due to efforts of various Universities & Institutes to obtain assignments from Industry. D D U has been making all out efforts to maintain /enhance the number/amount /areas of assignments. D. D. University has set up Centre for surface science & Nano Technology with encouragement from Government of Gujarat. Also Rs. 15 lacs each have also been received from ten sponsoring industries. The centre offers research facilities for training under graduates, Graduates and Doctoral students in areas of fundamental & applied

aspects of Surface science & Nanotechnology. It has created wealth of sophisticated instrumentation under one roof in order to address needs of R & D activities across the country. The Sponsoring business units & industry in general are the beneficiaries of the research work done. The center has also led to Student Development & faculty development by facilitating research activity by students & faculties. D D University also spends additional required funds from its resources.

ix. Service to the community:

D D University has been, at most reasonable rates, giving service to the community in the area of Dental health care by providing facility of ultra-modern dental hospital with service of well qualified & experienced doctors. Also under TEQUIP amount of Rs.10.34 Lacs is spent for services to community, apart from that D D University helping NGO like SEWA in achieving their laudable goals like women upliftment & development by arranging training, making infrastructure available for their activities.

Instrumentation engineering, through MELT Project of MHRD, have given knowledge e-contents, to students in schools in far flung area in Kheda district. Many students have been beneficiary of the programme.

Shah-Schulman centre for surface science & Nano technology has made available research facilities for researchers. The research results are passed on to sponsoring industrial units on only cost bases. The focus of the centre is solving technical problems of industries & developing new technology / new technical solutions, through innovative & strategic research.

Similarly by becoming Anchor Institute, D D University has been able to train persons from Industry, students as well as faculties all over Gujarat.

Computer Engineering Department has, under able leadership of Prof. C.K. Bheshdadia has executing following two projects by Ministry of Communication & IT, Govt. of India,
