HIGHLIGHTS OF INTER-CLASS EVENT :

BADMINTON :

Badminton Singles and Mixed Doubles was played for 5 days from 12th March 2022, Saturday to 16th March 2022, Wednesday. A girl or boy as an individual were allowed to participate in Badminton Singles while a team of 1 boy and 1 girl were allowed to participate in Badminton

Mixed Doubles. Nominal participation fee of 10/- Rs per person was charged to the participants for badminton singles, while 20/- Rs nominal fee per team were charged in Badminton Mixed Doubles. An aggregate of 180 participants appeared for Badminton Singles while 170 teams appeared for Badminton Mixed Doubles and a draw of 256 teams was done.

Two coordinators of Sports Club (FOT), 2 referees along with 8 volunteers were engaged to maintain proper flow of the game. Badminton singles and doubles were played in the ground besides the IT department. A tentative schedule of the match was circulated among the participants in the WhatsApp group and the teams were summoned according to the schedule.



Badminton Single Boys and Girls

Round 1 of Badminton Singles was commenced on 12th March 2022, Saturday. There were a total of 256 draws. Out of these 128 participants made their way to Round 2. Round 2 was held on 13th March 2022, Sunday. An aggregate of 64 participants were qualified to Round 3. Round 3 was held on 14th March 2022, Monday. Out of 64 participants, 32 were qualified for Round 4. Round 4 and Quarterfinals were commenced on 15th March 2022, Tuesday. Respected Head of Department faculties also enjoyed by playing Badminton. The semifinals and finals of Badminton singles were held on 16th March 2022, Thursday and the winner and the runner up of Badminton singles boys and girls were selected.

Badminton Mixed doubles

Round 1 for Badminton Mixed Doubles was commenced on 12th March 2022, Saturday. There were a total of 256 draws. Out of these 128 participants made their way to Round 2. Round 2 was held on 13th March 2022, Sunday. An aggregate of 64 participants were qualified to Round 3. Round 3 was held on 14th March 2022, Monday. Out of 64 participants, 32 were qualified for Round 4. Round 4 and Quarterfinals were commenced on 15th March 2022, Tuesday. The semifinals and finals of Badminton Mixed Doubles were held on 16th March 2022, Thursday and the winner and the runner up of Badminton mixed doubles were selected.



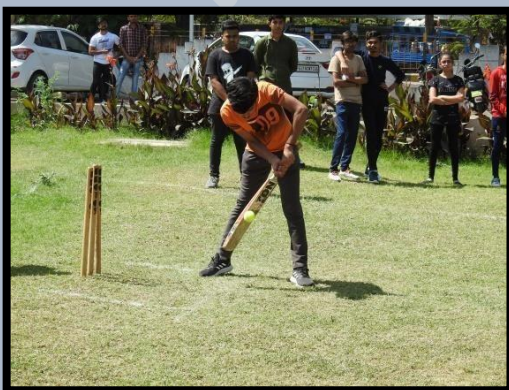
BOX-CRICKET :

Blaster of the Box was a Box Cricket tournament that was played from 12th March 2022, Saturday to 16th March 2022, Wednesday. Each team was of 7 members in which it was mandatory to keep 5 Boys and 2 Girls. The game of Box Cricket was of 6 overs. A nominal participation fee of 50/- Rs was charged for each team. 5 members of sports club FOT and 3 referees were there for the smooth coordination of the game. A draw of 64 was made and played on.



Round1 of box cricket was on 12th March 2022, Saturday, and 13th March 2022, Sunday. An aggregate of 32 teams made their way to Round 2. Round 2 was scheduled for the 14th of March 2022, Monday. 16 teams were filtered from Round 2 and were encouraged for Round 3. Round 3 and Quarterfinals were scheduled on 15th March 2022, Tuesday.

The teams which qualified from the quarterfinals were promoted to the Semifinals. The Semifinals and finals were held on 16th March 2022, Wednesday morning. With the final toss of the game winners and runner-ups were declared and awarded.



CARROM :

The oiled wooden carrom game, flicks and strikes was scheduled for 3 days from 14th March 2022, Monday to 16th March 2022, Wednesday. It comprised two types of fixtures: Individual and Team (2 members). Individual participants and Teams were nominally charged an amount of 10/- Rs and 20/- Rs. respectively. A total of 2 coordinators of the Sports Club (FOT) and 1 volunteer was engaged to maintain the discipline during the game. Flicks and strikes was played near the Centre Foyer. A total of 20 singles participants and 51 pairs were there in the league for the winning position. A tentative schedule for the matches was circulated among the captains of the respective teams. Round 1 of Carrom was scheduled on 14th March 2022, Monday. 14 teams won the draw and were encouraged further for Round2.



Round 2 was held on 15th March 2022, Monday. Out of a total of 14 teams, 9 winning teams were advanced to Round 3.

Round 3 was conducted on the same day itself. Quarterfinals and Semifinals were scheduled 16th March, 2022. The top 2 teams, after qualifying the semifinals positioned themselves on the hot seats for the finals. The finals were scheduled on 16th March 2022, Wednesday.



On the other hand carrom singles were also carried out simultaneously. Out of 20 participants, 8 managed to enter the round 2. The finals was carried out on 16th March, 2022.

CHESS :

The staggering checker board game, 'CHESS' was scheduled for 4 days from 14th March 2022, Monday to 16th March 2022, Wednesday. Each player was nominally charged an amount of 10/- Rs.



The Criteria for the team were structured to maintain the decorum during the event. It was carried out in 3 levels. A total of 2 coordinators of the Sports Club (FOT) and 1 volunteer were engaged to maintain the discipline during the game. Unruly Knight was played at Central Foyer.

A total of 64 draws were there in the league for the winning position. A tentative schedule for the matches was circulated among the captains of the respective teams. Round 1 of Unruly Knights was scheduled on 14th March 2022, Saturday.

Round 2 was held on 15th March 2022, Tuesday. The finals were scheduled on 16th March 2022, Wednesday. Winners and Runners up were awarded with trophy.



KABBADI :

The 5 membered team game, Le Panga was scheduled for 4 days from 12th March 2022, Saturday to 16th March 2022, Wednesday. Each team was nominally charged an amount of 50/- Rs. The Criteria for the team were structured to maintain decorum during the event.



A team needed to be comprised of 5 boys only and there should not be a mixed team of girls and boys. A total of 3 coordinators of the Sports Club (FOT) and 3 volunteers were engaged to maintain discipline during the game. Le Panga was played in the garden, near the dean's office.



A total of 32 draws and 32 teams were there in the league for the winning position. A tentative schedule for the matches was circulated among the captains of the respective teams. Round 1 of Le Panga was scheduled for the 12th of March 2022, Saturday. 16 teams won the draw and were encouraged further for Round 2.

Round 2 was held on the 14th of March 2022, Monday. Out of a total of 16 teams, 8 winning teams were advanced to Round 3. Round 3 was conducted on 15th March 2022, Tuesday.

Quarterfinals and Semi-finals were also scheduled on the same day. The top 2 teams, after qualifying for the semifinals positioned themselves in the ring of fire for the finals. The finals were scheduled for 16th March 2022, Wednesday. Winners and runners up were awarded at cultural night.



KHO-KHO :

Kho-Rathera was a 7 member Kho-Kho team game that was played for 3 days from 14th March 2022 to 16th March 2022. An amount of 50/- Rs was charged to each team as a participation fee. The team comprised of all boys participants or mixed participants i.e Girls + Boys as per the convenience of the team.



Three coordinators of a Sports Club (FOT) and one volunteer referee were engaged to run the game smoothly and maintain discipline. Kho-Rather was played in the Center Foyer garden. An aggregate of 16 teams participated in Round 1. Round 1 was on the 14th of March 2022, Monday. 8 teams were filtered for Round 2 Dr. B.R. Zala sir was the referee of the event.



The quarterfinals and semifinals were scheduled for 15th March 2022, Tuesday. Two teams marked their position to the finals from the semifinals. The finals of Kho-Rather were scheduled for 16th March 2022, Wednesday.



TABLE TENNIS :

Table Tennis tournament was organized for both singles and mixed-doubles participants. Table Tennis Tournament started 14th March Wednesday. Each team of mixed doubles was nominally charged an amount of 20/- Rs and participants for singles were charged 10/- Rs. A total of 2 coordinators of the Sports Club (FOT) were engaged to conduct the event fluidly. Ping X Pong was played in the indoor sports room in the basement of Dr. N. D. Desai Medical College. A total of 36 participants were evenly spread, the competition was played in the league format.



Whereas, for Mixed-doubles there were a total of 8 teams. A tentative schedule for the matches was circulated among all the Participants. Round 1 was held between 11 am to 1 pm. Round 1 consisted of 1 set of total 11 points. At the end of Round 1, a total of 16 participants qualified for round 2. After a short break Round 2 commenced. After Round 2, 8 participants were in the race for the trophy. Quarter-Finals were scheduled before lunch break. After 4 Quarter-Finals we got our Semifinalists.



Semifinals and Finals for singles as well as, Quarter-finals for doubles were held after lunch break at 4 pm. After the nail-biting semi-finals, the top 2 players secured their shot for the Finals. On the other hand Finalists for doubles were also decided. The Finals for Singles were held after the finals for mixed-doubles. With the toss by Dr. B. R. Zala, the Finals were started. The finals consisted of Total 5 sets, which were of 11 points each. The winner was decided on the bases of best of all five sets.



TUG OF WAR :

The 7 membered team game, Tug of war was scheduled for 4 days from 12th March 2022, Saturday to 16th March 2022, Wednesday. Each team was nominally charged an amount of 50/- Rs. The Criteria for the team were structured to maintain the decorum during the event. It was mandatory that a team should comprised of 5 boys and 2 girls and the total weight of the team should not exceed 600 Kgs.



A total of 2 coordinators of the Sports Club (FOT) and 3 volunteer were engaged to maintain the discipline during the game. Roaring and Roping was played in the garden, near the dean's office. A draw of 32 was made for 32 teams. A tentative schedule for the matches was circulated among the captains of the respective teams. Knock-out rounds consisted of 3 set only whereas Finals were consisted of a total of 5 sets. The winning team was decided on the basis of best of 5 sets.

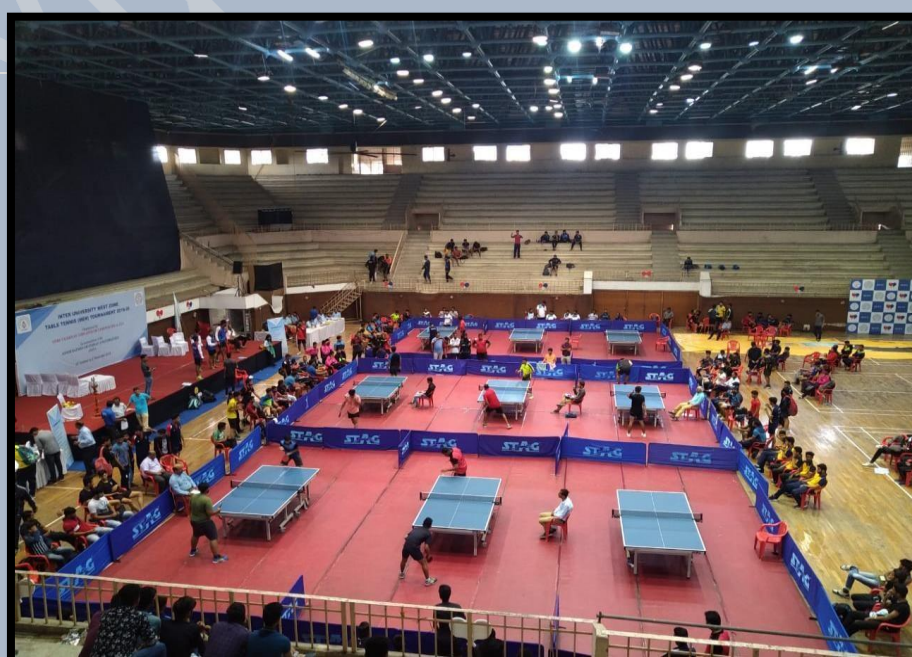

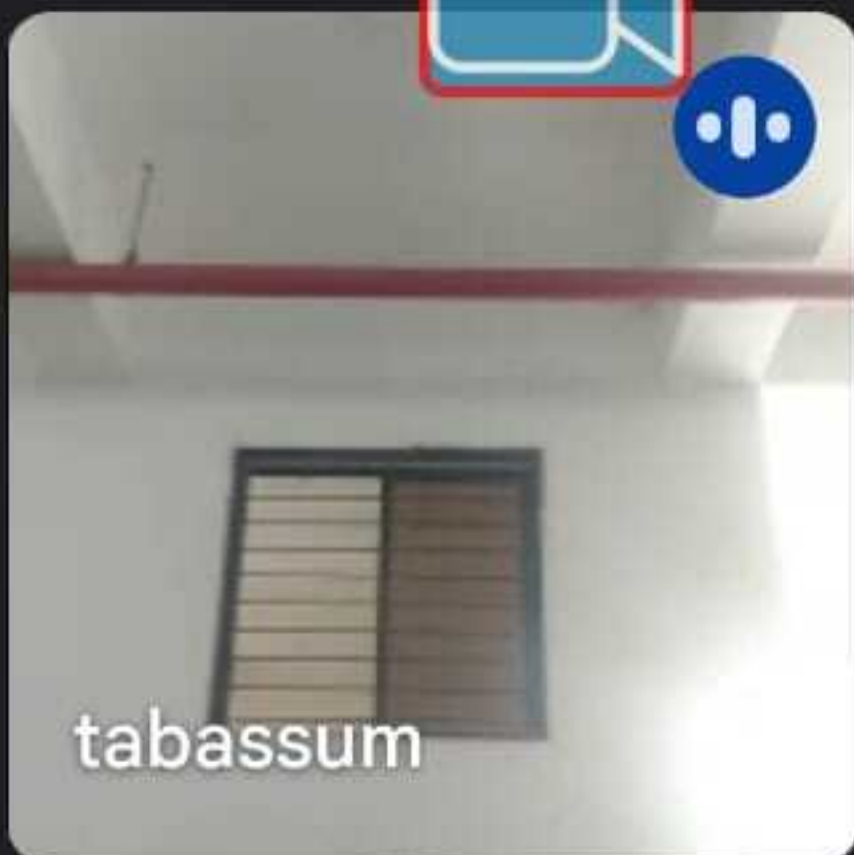

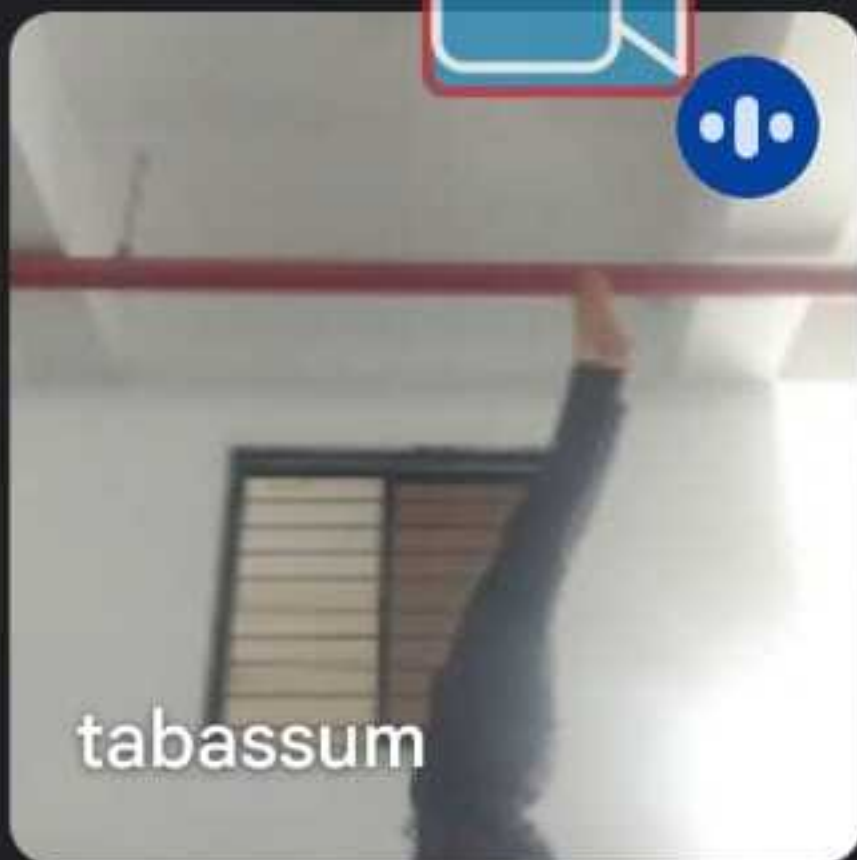
