I am happy to inform you that the Association has made good progress at several fronts under the present team of office Barrers.

It has been the motto of the association to:

Initiate academic activities by motivating the students for curricular and extra-curricular activities

Sustain the academic and extracurricular activities by providing financial and other supports to the students and organizers.

Provide financial support to deserving needy students.

1. I am happy to inform you that Mr Pradip Dalal (alumnus of 2<sup>nd</sup> batch of chemical engineering) has established a corpus of US \$ 1,00,000/- (one lakh US dollar) in the name of "Pradip & Daksha Dalal Family Endowment Fund for awarding four scholarships, each of Rs. 25,000/- to the engineering students of DDU. An agreement through DDUAA has been signed. The Association takes pride in having such members and thankfully acknowledges the generous donation by Mr Dalal. During the year a sum of Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rs. Two lakh) was awarded to eight students.

2. Awarding merit-cum-means scholarship of Rs. 5000/- each to 14 students, amounting to a total sum of Rs 70,000/- (Rupees seventy thousand) in 2021-22.
3. Smt. Jayagauri Joshipura Paritoshik instituted by Mr. Urvish is awarded to the topper of final year Chemical Engineering student Mr Naivil D Modi
4. Association has started the project of "Distribution of full-scale note books at the concessional rate to the students" in 2009 and has become permanent project of the Association. The expense for the same for the year 2021-22 was Rs.5,87,000/-


6. As there was no nominations for the election of office bearers, the present team of office bearers are requested to continue for the next term.


1. The president Dr. H.M. Desai called the meeting to order and welcomed the members to AGM.


