The first speaker of the awareness programme was Dr. M.S.Rao sir, Coordinator of IQAC, Dharmsinh Desai University, Nadiad. Mr. Rao talked about the IQAC and how it works to let the students understand exactly why do we need this types of cells. Breathing Practice by Pranayam is the Yogic Exercise of focusing on Breath. In Sanskrit, 'Prana' means "Vital Life Force", and 'Yama' means to gain control.
